


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What does "ethos" mean?

It is the spirit, character, principles or essence of someone.






Here—Gesar Khan. Here—Aryavarta. Here is Shambhala.

Retreat of the Blue Lotus

Few of you remember your experiences with me on the inner, yet, I encourage you to seek that oneness from within the great silence of your heart and the great stillness. . .



- Etheric retreats are homes and schools of light
- Antahkarana the web of life/light for the planet
- Ongoing instruction from ascended master teachers

- The main hall has lotus flowers floating in a pool carved into the floor.
- A wall opens to an antechamber which is the flame room, where a lotus flame on the altar is a focus of the three-fold flame. An intense blue flame forms the petals of the lotus, golden flame blazes from the center, pink radiance emanates.
- The walls are rough hewn—showing the beauty of the rock.
- The only decoration is the flame itself and a statue of a figure in meditation.
- Those who serve here wear white linen robes.
- There are seven chambers, one on top of the other. Initiates begin in the lowest, largest chamber and are allowed to ascend to the next layer after passing tests of self-mastery. The chambers are separated by hundreds of feet of solid rock. A spiral staircase connects the first three, beyond that you must levitate or adjust your atomic pattern to enter through the walls.
- Receive a mantra that is a key to fulfilling your divine plan

Perfect stillness you must know.


And in that knowing all will be known by you in the soundless sound of the One.

I must not fear. Fear is the mind-killer. Fear is the little-death that brings total obliteration. I will face my fear. I will permit it to pass over me and through me.


